Few topics are as complex as religion, and few educational references do as impressive a job of summing up in clear, precise, and easy-to-understand prose the precepts, history, and practices of the world's major faiths. Michael D. Coogan has all the background to tackle such a formidable task. Currently the director of publications for the Harvard Semitic Museum, he has taught at Harvard and Wellesley, excavated in Israel, Jordan, and Egypt, and edited both the *Oxford Companion to the Bible* and the *Oxford History of the Biblical World*. Beautifully illustrated with artwork, photography, maps, and graphs, this guide provides a lucid introduction to Judaism, Christianity, Islam, Buddhism and Hinduism, as well as the religious traditions of China and Japan. Coogan explains each religion's origins and divine beliefs, sacred texts and individuals, the concepts of death and the afterlife, and how the religion is expressed in society, rites of passage, education, and gender roles. Books on world religions have a problem defining what a "world religion" is, and this one is no different. Coogan (religious studies, Stonehill Coll.) solicited contributions from scholars in seven major world religions: Judaism, Christianity, Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism, and Chinese and Japanese traditions. These choices were based on three criteria: number of followers, world geographic diffusion, and historical importance. Thus, Sikhism, Zoroastrianism, and the sacred traditions of the Native Americans, Africa, and Oceania are not included, while traditions based in China and Japan, respectively, are lumped together owing to population merit. Whether or not the reader agrees with these criteria, they certainly limit the usefulness and comprehensiveness of a book with the phrase "world religions" in its title. That said, the information included, although merely introductory, is accurate and presented in lively prose, and the color photographs and maps greatly enhance reading pleasure.
